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REGULATORY POLICY



It is conducted a systematical work aimed on identification of incorrect regulations and prevention of their implementation. It is carried out the expertise of about **2,000** drafts of regulatory acts annually within this work



The level of preparation of regulatory acts by CEB and local government authorities and the regulatory impact assessment remains low. SRA refuses to approve almost every **3rd** CEB project because of their low-quality and numerous violations in carrying out of the regulatory impact assessment



Since March 2016 it is implemented a newest regulatory instrument - M-test within the adopted by Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine the updated **Methodology** of regulatory impact assessment, which is more clearly, defines standards of regulatory impact assessment (RIA), its elements and procedures

DEREGULATION



A number of burdening bureaucratic conditions in the industry was cancelled



It's being protected and strengthened the rights of minority investors



In the sphere of construction has been reduced a period for issuing technical conditions and improved the procedure for submitting the declaration of performance of preparatory and constructional works



Aiming to simplify the procedure of registration of land rights on agricultural purpose plots, the notaries were given the power on registration of property rights on the land plots



It was minified the list of goods the export and import of which were mandatory to licensing



There were improved the public procurement regulations



It was introduced the declarative principle of state investment accounting




It was simplified the declaration form of conformity the material-technik base of legal requirements on fire safety and canceled the obligatoriness of approval of technologic maps of restaurant business by sanitary and epidemiological control bodies




It's being opened more than 300 free access government databases and registries



DEREGULATION



It is reduced from five days to 24 hours the term of issue of phytosanitary and quarantine certificates




The list of facilities mandatory for quarantine minified on 33 points for internal transportation




It is canceled an excessive administration in the sphere of circulation pesticides and agrochemicals




The state registration of dietary products was canceled



It was liquidated the corrupted system of collection, harvesting and utilization of waste as secondary raw materials as well as liquidated the state company «Ukrekokomresursy»



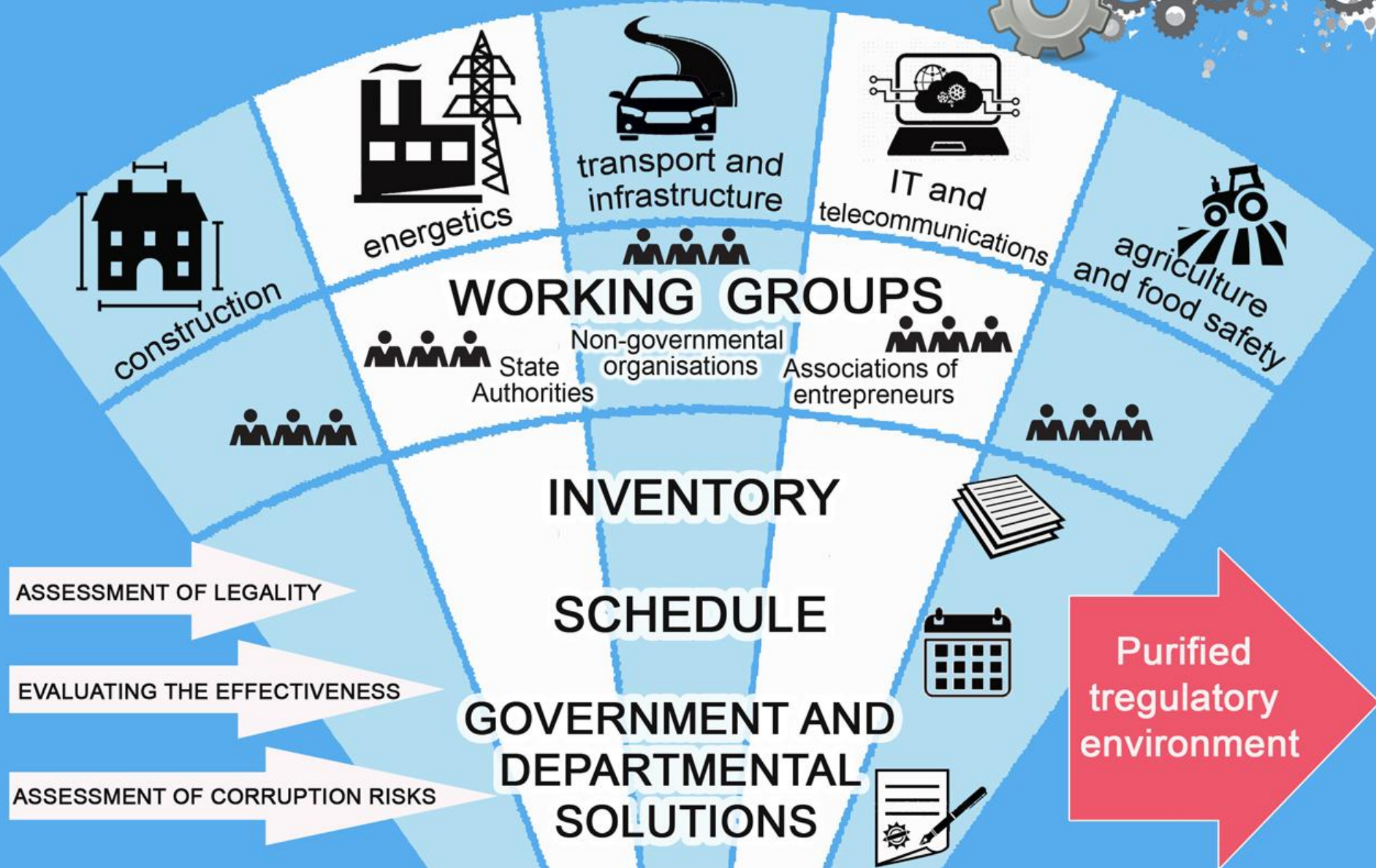
It was canceled the manual radiological control of cargo in case the port has stationary devices
